THE FIRST MEDITERRANEAN SANDA TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

COMPETITION GENERAL INFORMATION

DATE & PLACE

The First Mediterranean Sanda Team Championship will take place between December 1 and 3, 2017 in Athens, Greece.

QUALIFICATIONS

Those eligible to participate are National Mediterranean Teams from IWUF member countries that are members of the International Committee of Mediterranean Games:

- Africa (*Algeria, Egypt, Libya, Morocco and Tunisia*);
- Asia (*Lebanon and Syria*);
- Europe (*Albania, Andorra, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Cyprus, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, Monaco, Montenegro, San Marino, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain and Turkey*).

Other National Federations could be allowed to participate to the First Mediterranean Sanda Team Championship only with the authorization of the Working Group for Mediterranean Wushu.

Each participating country may at most submit one (1) team.

Each participating country's team is limited to a total of (23) people, which comprises of the following:

- One (1) team leader;
- One (1) coach;
- One (1) doctor;
- Up to two (2) judges;
- Fourteen (18) athletes (seven female athletes and eleven male athletes, who were born between January 1, 1982 – November 30, 1999; maximum one athlete per medalizing Sanda event);

Each Sanda competitor should bring along with them a valid health certificate (including electroencephalogram – EEG, electrocardiogram – ECG, pulse and blood pressure) issued within 30 days prior to the beginning of the competition signed by a qualified doctor and a Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate. All competitors are required to submit a completed and signed waiver of liabilities form.

COMPETITION EVENTS

Each team will consist of up to 18 (eighteen) athletes (seven female athletes and eleven male athletes) that will compete in the following categories (maximum one athlete per medalizing Sanda event):

- a. Men's divisions (11 events):
 - i. 48 Kg;
 - ii. 52 Kg;
 - iii. 56 Kg;
 - iv. 60 Kg;
 - v. 65 Kg;

- vi. 70 Kg;
 - vii. 75 Kg;
 - viii. 80 Kg;
 - ix. 85 Kg;
 - x. 90 Kg;
 - xi. 90 Kg +
- b. Women's division (7 events):
- i. 48 Kg;
 - ii. 52 Kg;
 - iii. 56 Kg;
 - iv. 60 Kg;
 - v. 65 Kg;
 - vi. 70 Kg;
 - vii. 75 Kg.

The system of competition will be based on individual matches under the knock out system. The places in each weight category will be awarded as follow:

- 10 points for the 1st place;
- 8 points for the 2nd place;
- 5 points for the 3rd place (juxtaposition);
- 3 points for the 5th place (juxtaposition);
- 1 point for the 9th place (juxtaposition).

3 (Three) additional points will be awarded to the athlete for each match won (except for the match won by walkover).

The team has achieved the highest points will be placed as the first in the "Team Competition", and so on and so forth. If two or more teams have achieved equal points, the placing will be determined through the following sequence: (1) The team with more individual first places will be placed higher. If the tie remains, the team with more individual second places will be placed higher, and so on and so forth. (2) The team with fewer warnings will be placed higher. (3) The team with fewer admonitions will be placed higher. If following the above process a tie remains, the teams will share the tied place.

ENTRIES

All final entries must reach the organizing committee and the IWUF Secretariat no later than 24:00 (Eastern European Time – EET) November 6, 2017. These must be sent by email to the below addresses:

ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

All participating teams and technical officials are required to arrive at the designated registration booth and register with the Organizing Committee on December 1, 2017. Arrival after the designated time may result in disqualification of the participant in question.

Any entry not duly confirmed at the Technical Meeting, will not be taken into consideration except for force majeure.

TECHNICAL MEETING

The Technical Meeting for team leader and coaches will take place at the designated place on December 1, 2017 in the afternoon during which all matters related to the competition will be announced.

DRAWING – LOTS CEREMONY

The drawing – lots will be conducted following the weighing – in on December 2, 2017.

WEIGHING – IN

The weighing – in will take place at 07:00 on December 2, 2017.

PLACING AND AWARDS

- Individual
 - 1st place Certificate;
 - 2nd place Certificate;
 - 3rd place (juxtaposition) Certificate;
 - 5th place (juxtaposition) Certificate.
- Team
 - 1st place Cup and Gold medal for athletes;
 - 2nd place Cup and Silver medal for athletes;
 - 3rd place (juxtaposition) Cup and Bronze medal for athletes;

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The international airfare and related travel expenses, as well as accommodation/participation fees of all participants (athletes, judges and team officials) shall be borne by the teams themselves.

ACCOMMODATION

The official hotel to be used is :

President Hotel Athens 4 star (www.president.hotelsathens.org)

Accommodation will be based on a “per person per day” for one person in a single room, two people in a double room and three people sharing a three bed room.

Breakfast, lunch, dinner and transportation are included in the price. Lunch will be provided in the stadium.

Costs :

Single Room : 77,00 euro per person per day

Double Room : 60,00 euro per person per day

Three Bed Room : 55,00 euro per person per day

Any extra costs associated with rooms (mini-bar, sauna etc.) shall be the responsibility of the individual.

Only official hotel will be used. Participants shall be required to use the official hotel as a condition of participation for the reason that we have already booked the hotel rooms.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control could be conducted during the First Mediterranean Sanda Championships according to the requirements of the International Wushu Federation and the World Anti – Doping Agency.

SANDA COMPETITION METHODS

Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the 2017 edition the “Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Method”.

The duration of each round shall be 2 (two) minutes with a 1 (one) minute rest interval between rounds.

SANDA COSTUMES AND EQUIPMENT

Competitors shall wear costumes and protective gear in compliance with the “Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Method” to participate in the competition.

Each competitor is required to possess two (2) sets of competition costumes: one set in blue and one set in red. Each competitor is required to possess his or her own mouth guard, jockstrap, and instep guard. The Organizing Committee will provide gloves and other protective equipment.
